PCDP 2018 Highlights Provided for the State of the County Presentation

- New jobs and significant capital investments were made in manufacturing companies across the County in 2018
- The Partnership is working with the new owner of the Old Hines Truck Stop in application for Ohio's Abandoned Gas Station Clean Up Grant Fund – application for up to \$500,000
- The PCDP approved 50% funding for the cost of a second feasibility study to gain a greater prospective on the demand for a hotel
- The Partnership supported and funded 50% the cost of the new electronic sign at the fairgrounds
- Preble County Revolving Loan Fund (RLF) is at \$500,000
- The PCDP RLF fund is at \$125,000 - approved/supported a small business in Lewisburg with a loan of \$15,000 assisting in their startup
- The Partnership has invested in a Job Portal in order to gain a simpler mechanism of posting Preble County jobs and marketing local business opportunities
- Preble County reached goals needed to maintain the Certified ACT Work Ready Community status (a valuable economic and workforce development tool)
- In partnership with the PCDP, Cargill hosted the Regional BusinessFirst! Outreach meeting with Economic Developers and Resource Partners from across the Region in attendance (this helps showcase business partners in the County)

The primary focuses of the Partnership are business retention, new business recruitment, marketing and community outreach, and workforce development.
